## 1. PulsimSuite License Server (Sentinel)

Only if you do not already have Sentinel License Manager (version 10.2 or higher) installed, this needs to be installed. Please use the instructions in the **Install License Manager 10.2.pdf** document, and the installer and tools in directory **LicenseManagerSentinel10\_2** of the package you downloaded.


## 2. PulsimSuite Installation on Clients

In the downloaded installation package, you will find the **PulsimSuite** directory that contains the PulsimSuite installer.


### *Installation start*

Start the installation of PulsimSuite by running setup.msi.


### Installation of PulsimSuite






The license server of PulsimSuite (or your PC hostname) must now be filled in the box:



DO NOT LEAVE THIS BOX EMPTY. The license server name in this picture is just an example. Do not use that name, but use the name of the PC where your Sentinel License Server is running. Make sure not to type any spaces before or after the name.







The PulsimSuite installation is complete, but you also need the following two items (if not installed already for a previous version of PulsimSuite).

### **3. MATLAB Runtime: MCR 9.2**

The PulsimSuite pulsation results are post-processed by routines built with MATLAB Runtime components. For these routines to work, MCR version 9.2 needs to be installed. If you have not already done this installation (e.g. for previous PulsimSuite versions), this free software can be downloaded from the MathWorks site: <https://www.mathworks.com/products/compiler/matlab-runtime.html>

Make sure to install version 9.2 of the MCR.

### **4. Microsoft Office**

For the “detailed report generation” and “detailed table report generation” you will need to have installed Microsoft Word and Excel, respectively, version 2010 or higher. For Word, you also need to set the language settings to English (either US or British). In Word, go to File → Options → Language, and set both the “editing” and the “display” language to English. Note: to our knowledge, our report generator only works when either US or British English is selected.
